Olympic Cross Country track Beijing, China

Beijing Organising Committee of the Olympic Games (BOCOG)

With the addition of new, technically difficult, sections the track was brought into line with Olympic competition standards. The development of cutting edge design techniques provided a good spectacle for TV viewers and improved racing and overtaking possibilities.



Thetford Forest Cross Country track Thetford, Norfolk

Forestry Commission

Contracted by Pearl Construction to design and supervise construction of several sections of cross country trail. Sections of the track that had fallen into disrepair due to poor original design, construction and lack of armouring were reconstructed. The new tracks were raised off the flat topography by soil inversion and then armoured with a thick layer of crushed stone.

Kielder Forest Red Route

Forestry Commission

Working closely with the Forestry Commission and trail designer a route was tagged over the fell, traversing a recently felled site over deep peat. Three specialist 'bogmaster' excavators created a floating mat using tree roots and stumps before suitable material was imported to create exciting features, along with landscaping the areas adjacent to the new route.



Siddick Link Cycleway West Cumbria

Cumbria County Council

Commissioned to design and manage a new cycleway linking the C2C (Route 71) with Hadrian's Cycleway (Route 72). Challenges included the presence of a nationally rare butterfly, ground contamination, traveller encampments and fly tipping. Our design solution reconciled these issues by combining sensitive design, negotiation and innovative use of highway law.

Pennine Bridleway National Trail Yorkshire Dales National Park

Natural England

Commissioned to undertake landowner negotiations, site survey (geotechnical, topographical and ecological) of two sections of the Pennine Bridleway within the National Park. Following this survey work a detailed route was designed and a planning application prepared on behalf of the client.



Ainsdale Sand Dunes National Nature Reserve

Natural England

Appointed to upgrade a 3.5km route that, along with access for wheelchair users, horses, cyclists and pedestrians, was used by emergency services. After a detailed site survey and assessment a sympathetic restoration methodology was proposed, and engineers designed a bespoke frame sledge to ensure a constant camber, width and depth of material along the entire track.
